Leavers

If you have been offered a school place for September, please add your child's name to my leavers list, on the aunties table, along with the new school they will be attending. We have a transition morning with all the schools in the borough and do a hand over to the new school.

Weather

As you know we do go outside daily, so with that in mind, please dress your child accordingly. With the great British weather anything can happen! As the weather gets warmer, please make sure that your child has a sunhat, has sun cream applied and a coat at school every day.

Attendance and punctuality

For some of you this will be the last term that your child will be with us before

moving onto big school. One of the questions the new school asks us is about your child's attendance and lateness. With this in mind, your child's attendance and lateness for the last term will be recorded and sent to their new school. We have also noticed lots of parents "hanging round" at drop off, this does have an impact on our day as we can not get the doors closed on time. Free play is our time to work with your child to help them with their development and if our team are waiting on doors closing, they cannot work with their key children.

Labels

Please make sure your child's jumpers, coats, hats, and lunch boxes are clearly labelled. (Label should be on the outside of the lunch box.) Water bottles may be brought into school clearly named and may only contain **water** inside please.
